### **A Joint Resolution of Support of Virginia General Assembly House Bill Number 1840**

**WHEREAS**, Delegate Daniel W. Marshall, III, has introduced House Bill Number 1840 into the Virginia General Assembly for consideration in the 2019 session, which directs the State Corporation Commission to establish pilot programs by Dominion Energy Virginia and Appalachian Power; and

**WHEREAS**, the pilot programs will have the purpose of promoting economic development in the rural areas of the Commonwealth by allowing the utility to complete the construction phase of electric transmission infrastructure for a business park prior to the public announcement of a prospective occupant of the business park; and

**WHEREAS**, the Wildwood Commerce Park is a business park by definition of the bill and is an economic development project that will serve the citizens of the counties of Carroll and Grayson and the City of Galax; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of supervisors of the County of Carroll desire to support said legislation by joining with the affected localities in approving this joint resolution;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Carroll County Board of Supervisors does hereby **RESOLVE** to support House Bill Number 1840 for the purpose of permitting Appalachian Power to complete the construction phase of electric transmission infrastructure for Wildwood prior to the public announcement of a prospective occupant of the business park.
